Proposal to Allow Clerical (Non-substantive) Changes to the OPTN Bylaws and Policies

- Currently out for public comment
- Initial comments are supportive of the proposal
- On the non-discussion agenda at regional meetings
- All changes reviewed retrospectively by the Executive Committee





Definition of Organ Transplant

- Public Comment fall 2014
- UNOS staff routinely receive questions from OPTN/UNOS members about the definition of "organ transplant"
- Will clarify what should be reported as the transplant date, especially reporting requirements in UNetSM.
- Will help to bridge the disconnect in current definitions and actual clinical practices





Clean-up of Multi-Organ Policies

- Public Comment fall 2014
- Collaborative multi-organ policies workgroup with representatives from organ specific committees and OPO committee created proposed policy language
- Updating the current policy language that deals generally with multi-organ candidates and offers (mainly Policy 3.4, 5.4, and 5.8)
- Proposed language will be presented to the full POC in July for a vote





Policy Rewrite "Parking Lot" – Quick Fixes

- Public Comment fall 2014
- Addresses simple substantive fixes identified during the policy plain language rewrite
- Other committees will review drafts of proposed "quick fixes" before final proposal
- Other parking lot items that will take additional research and work will be handled as committee projects and prioritized with other projects


Committee Project Review

Improve survival for patients post-transplant


Increase access to transplants

- 17 proposals currently out for public comment
